

- 1. Sex is a normal behaviour displayed on the basis of love and marriage.
- 2. Adolescents should not have sex casually because:
 - a) "sex" is not equivalent to "love"; love is mutual respect and care for one another instead of satisfaction of lust recklessly;
 - b) it is possible to contract diseases:
 - sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) [such as herpes, genital warts, AIDS, gonorrhoea, syphilis];
 - hepatitis B or C;
 - c) the earlier a girl starts having sex or the more sex partners she has, the higher is her chance of having cervical cancer; and
 - d) promiscuity and unexpected pregnancy would bring along enormous psychological stress and trauma as well as unbearable consequences.
- 3. Learn contraceptive methods for future family planning.
 - a) Common and effective contraceptive methods used in Hong Kong include:
 - oral contraceptives (prescribed by doctors after assessment); and
 - ◆ male condoms (must be put on properly).
 - b) No contraceptive method is totally reliable.
 - c) Using condoms can reduce the chance of contracting AIDS and STDs but they are not entirely safe.

Steps in Using Condoms

- i) Check the expiry date from the wrapper and ensure that it is intact.
- ii) Open the wrapper carefully and do not use sharp objects such as scissors for such purpose.
- iii) Check whether the condom is intact and distinguish between the outer and inner sides (the rim rolls up the outer side).
- iv) Put the condom on an erect penis before it contacts the vagina.
 - Gently pinch the apex of the condom to squeeze air out of the reservoir tip to facilitate the storage of semen ejaculated.
 - Roll the condom carefully down the entire shaft of the erect penis while still pitching the apex and do not let fingernail or ring damage the condom.
- v) Apply water-based lubricant if required, since oil-based substances such as Vaseline or baby oil would deteriorate latex and render the condom ineffective.
- vi) Withdraw the penis while holding the rim of the condom immediately after ejaculation to prevent the condom from slipping off and beware of spillage of semen.
- vii) Check whether there is any leakage in the condom before disposing of it properly.

Adolescents should never ignore the adverse consequences of having sex.
